

Washington 10 Storage Corporation Short Term Storage Open Season

Storage Parameters

Maximum Storage Quantity (MSQ)

Up to 2,000,000 Dth January 1, 2011 through August 31, 2012 (20 months)

Maximum Daily Injection Quantity (MDIQ)

January 2011 – August 2012 3.3% of MSQ daily on an Interruptible basis

Maximum Daily Withdrawal Quantity (MDWQ)

January 2011 – April 2011 5.0% of MSQ daily on an Interruptible basis

May 2011 – December 2011 3.3% of MSQ daily on a Firm basis

January 2012 – April 2012 5.0% of MSQ daily on an Interruptible basis

May 2012 – August 2012 3.3% of MSQ daily on a Firm basis

Fuel

Fuel as per W10's Tariff. Current estimated Fuel Rate of 1.00% on injections and 0.50% on withdrawals.

Demand and Commodity Charges

- Demand Charges will be calculated as the Bid Rate times the MSQ divided by the number of months in the contract term and invoiced monthly.
- No Commodity Charges.
- Authorized Overrun injections and withdrawals are at a rate of \$0.05/Dth.
- Unlimited cycling.

Washington 10 Storage Corporation has been in service since 1999, is regulated by the Michigan Public Service Commission (MPSC) and holds a FERC Statement of Operating Conditions, giving it authority to sell intrastate and interstate services. In 2008, W10 received authority from the FERC to charge market-based rates for interstate services.

DTE Gas Storage Company is responsible for Operating, Managing and Marketing W10.
